Editor and Reviewer comments:

Reviewer #1: * The manuscript so matches with the journal focus.

- Abstract needs more focus on results.
- Eligibility criteria for participants need more specifics.
- How sample size was determined and, when applicable, explanation of any interim analyses and stopping rules is not clear.
- Need more clarity of results presentations

Reviewer #2: - There are several missing information that are required to enhance clarity of the presented information and guide the reader. For example:

- o In the introduction: please provide more information about the Indonesian national nursing Competence examination (NNCE). Is it a certification exam, is it for all graduating students regardless of their degrees, what are the available nursing educational degree in Indonesia (diploma, BSN ..etc), who administer the exam, is it mandatory for foreign or only local nurses, what is the passing rate, what are the general nursing fields/sections covered in the exam. These information is very important considering that NET is an international journal.
- o Field notes: which filed exactly? Is it while students taking the preparation course or the exam?
- o In the Method: More information about the qualitative part is needed. Who conducted the interviews, how long the interview conducted, was there an interview guide, what qualitative research approach was adopted, how thematic analysis was conducted? Without this information, the credibility of the presented concepts/themes is questionable.
- Page 2: add citation to Knowles' theory of adult learning. Add more description about the theory and how it guides the formation and evaluation of the model.
- In several places, the authors pointed to the previous study in which some steps were already covered. However, no citation or information provided about that study. More information is needed. Also, in-text citation to be added. For example, in Page 2 Design Section- add citation to the previous study that covers stage 1.
- Please provide more information explaining how the first inclusion criteria were assessed "dissatisfied over the NNCE pass rate? Also, why only participants who were dissatisfied included?
- Participants' Section: details and characteristics about study participants, including their age and gender, is better placed under the Results section.
- Provide a paragraph explaining how the trustworthiness 4 components for the generated concepted were ensured.


